FC will let us know. Carrie Tambling is making sleeping arrangements for them. There will be 12 coming, 3 staff, 9 "Friends." Advertisement for the concert: Al said he will send an email notice to everyone and can send a printed notice later.

Fundraisers: David Diestelkamp is investigating a bank draft program for contributors.

Scholarships: Joe Novak has not been sent any scholarship applications yet. The deadline is July 1, 2008. Karl suggested setting the scholarship amount that can be used at the next meeting in July.

New Business: Karl said we need to think about our scholarship policy on what should be required of a student/family (involvement with club, fundraisers etc). We will also need to discuss scholarships for 3rd and 4th year students at the next meeting.
